
Faculty Allocation

Faculty Allocation to Time Table is used to allocate faculty to the selected dates.







This page is used to send SMS alert to parent mobile number on specific date if their ward is absent on any subject
















Mark Entry




Hospital Information System (HIS)

HIS keep track of everything related to patients. This includes the patient's medical history, medication logs, contact information, appointment times, and billing. Login Page










OP Billing

The Out Patient (OP) billing module is used to generate bills for a particular patient with reference to the treatment undergone by him






